**Class1: Cob shoeing class.**

(Entry fee £25) Limited to the first 32 entrants.

Open to all registered farriers. Rough cut allowed. One  $\frac{3}{4}$  fullered shoe to be made and fitted to a foot and a specimen to be made to the judges specifications. Striker allowed. (GAS FORGE)

(Time allowed 55 mins.)

**Class2: Therapeutic Shoemaking.**

(Entry fee £25) Limited to the first 32 entrants.

Open to all registered farriers. Two therapeutic shoes to be made to the judges specifications. Striker allowed. (GAS FORGE)

(Time allowed 50 mins.)

**Class3: Speed Shoemaking.**

(Entry fee £10. Pay and enter on the day.)

Make a caulk and wedge  $\frac{1}{4}$  clipped shoe from 13  $\frac{1}{2}$ " of 3/4x7/16 concave bar with 3 minute pre heat. The best shoe takes it! (GAS FORGE)

(Time allowed 20 mins.)

**Class4; Apprentice shoemaking 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> years.**

(Entry fee £15)

Two rounds in which the competitor will make 2 pairs of shoes made to the judges specification. 2 minute pre-heat allowed. Out of own workstation/van.

(Time allowed 40 mins each round.)

**Class5: Apprentice shoemaking 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> years.**

(Entry fee £15)

Two rounds in which the competitor will make 2 pairs of shoes to be made to the judges specification. Fullering may be included. 2 minute pre-heat allowed. Out of own workstation/van.

(Time allowed 40 mins each round.)

**Class6: Apprentice Therapeutic shoemaking.**

(Entry fee £15)

Two therapeutic shoes to be made to the judges specification. Striker allowed. 2 minute pre-heat allowed. Out of own workstation/van.

(Time allowed 50 mins.)

**All apprentices will be required to work on their own workstations/vans. Gas will be supplied on the day at a discounted rate to avoid "Dangerous goods declaration" on the ferries, however if you still wish to bring your own gas, remember to inform Wightlink at time of booking.**

**PRIZES**

**Classes 1&2:**

1<sup>st</sup> : £150, 2<sup>nd</sup>: £100, 3<sup>rd</sup>: £50, 4<sup>th</sup> £20

**Classes 4 & 5:**

- \*All steel and nails will be provided. Specimen steel will be pre-cut.
- \*Competitors will be required to provide their own safety equipment, which should be worn at all times whilst competing.
- \*Any entries received after the closing date (4/8/2012) will not be accepted.
- \*Only competitors, strikers and officials will be allowed into the shoeing area.
- \*Any competitor who is not stationed at their designated workstation 5 minutes before their class will forfeit their entry.
- \*All work, including brushing, must cease when stewards call time up. Failure to comply may result in disqualification.
- \*Specimens will be published 2 weeks prior to the competition.
