Open Shoeing

Time limit TBC

Competitors to make two shoes to the judges specification. One for the horses foot and one specimen. Fireman allowed/no striker.

Intermediate Shoeing

Time limit TBC

Open to those who have not placed 1st or 2nd in a shoeing competition.

Competitor to make two shoes to the judges specification. One for the horses foot and one specimen. Fireman allowed/no striker.

Two-Person Open Shoemaking

Time limit TBC

Competitors will be required to make two shoes, one each to the judges description. Stricker allowed.

Apprentice Shoemaking Class

Time limit TBC

Competitors will be required to make two shoes to the judges description. Please state what year apprentice you are as class will be divided into 1st/2nd year and 3rd/4th year, depending on number of entries.

Eagle Eye Class

Competitors is allowed 10 seconds to look at a foot and then 10 minutes to forge a shoe to fit to judges description class will be split into open/apprentice.
